

Apartment Defects Campaign Update, 24 November, 2022 – PLEASE SHARE

CDA Protest, 1pm, Wednesday, 7 December at Leinster House

The Construction Defects Alliance will be holding a dignified protest outside Leinster House at 1pm on Wednesday, 7 December next and we are urging as many of you as possible—and your neighbours – to attend.

The purpose of the event is to mark the fifth anniversary of the completion of the Oireachtas Housing Committee's *Safe as Houses?* report which recommended the setting up of a redress scheme to ensure that ordinary owners who bought in good faith are not liable for the costs of remediating defects.

While work is underway on putting a remediation support scheme in place we want to use this demonstration to remind our policy makers of the urgency of this problem and the need to put a scheme in place that is fit-for-purpose – in other words, will ensure that people's homes are properly remediated so that they are safe and healthy to live in.

In addition to the protest at 1pm on 7 December, the Alliance will be speaking at a briefing for Oireachtas members and staff at 2pm on that day.
